



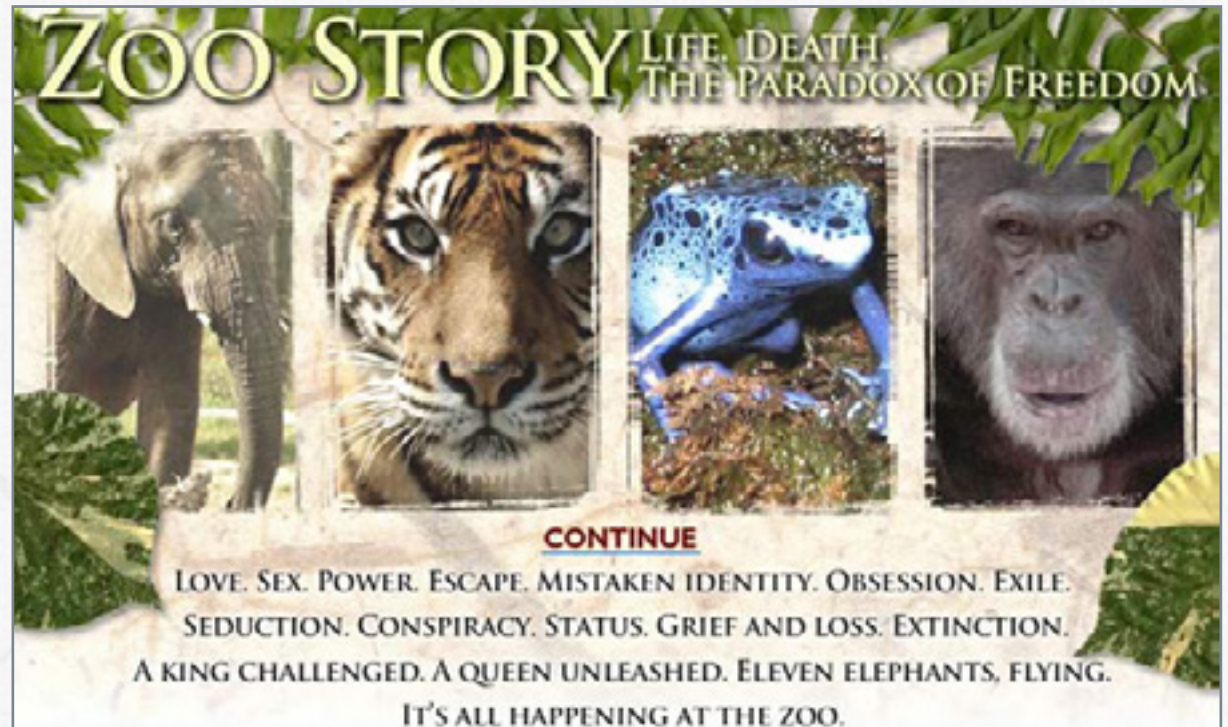

Against the Wind and Tide

The Indian River Lagoon covers half of Florida's east coast, stretching from Ponce de Leon Inlet in the north 156 miles to Jupiter Inlet in the south. Spanning the temperate and tropic zones, the lagoon is the most biologically diverse estuary in the United States. Long a destination for anglers seeking world records, the waterway is now part of the new Florida Circumnavigation Saltwater Paddling Trail, which enables kayakers to paddle around the state. On a cool weekend in December, six Tampa Bay kayakers embarked on what they hoped would be a pleasure cruise. They were mistaken.
